**Harmony Day Event:**

Following our SRC Assembly, students will complete a Harmony Day activity in buddy class groups. Teachers will guide students to explore what Harmony Day means. Harmony Day is a time to celebrate our differences and to foster a tolerance of others. Some of the themes to explore include:
